

NIST Multi-Cloud Security Public Working Group (MCSPWG)

DRAFT Meeting Minutes

Meeting #2, February 14, 2022

1. The meeting started at 3:01 PM ET, February 14, 2022.

 - In response to request for setting up the meeting at different time to accommodate global attendance, Michaela Iorga and Co-Chairs apologized that there is no plan to adjust at this time.

2. Chris Hughes displayed a compilation of the group topics survey. The harvest survey showed 20 for Zero Trust solutions in a multi-cloud ecosystem, 9 for authorization / certification of multi-cloud solutions, 2 for TIC 3.0 and 1 for data exchange security for interconnected CSPs. The discussion supported setting up sub-groups based on the interest on zero trust offers the opportunity to set up of sub-groups, e.g., identity / ID policy / ICAM / access control. The number of responses for authorization have potential to set up sub-groups, e.g., continuous/inventory monitoring or SBOM.
