

## ROY A. SWIFT, PH.D.

Senior Director American National Standards Institute (ANSI)

Roy A. Swift, Ph.D., is currently the senior director of personnel credentialing accreditation programs at ANSI. Prior to his current position, Dr. Swift was a consultant to educational, certification, licensure and health care organizations. From 1993-1998 he was executive director of the National Board for Certification in Occupational Therapy (NBCOT). This appointment followed a 28-year career in the United States Army Medical Department. In his last position, he was Chief of the Army Medical Specialist Corps in the Army Surgeon General's Office with policy responsibility for Army occupational therapists, physical therapists, dietitians and physician assistants throughout the world.

He has served on many national committees, non-profit Boards of Directors and federal and state government advisory committees. He has served as chaired the Assembly of Review Committee Chairs of the former Council on Allied Health Education and Accreditation of the American Medical Association, Chair, American Occupational Therapy Association Accreditation Committee, and on the Secretary of the Department of Veterans Affairs Advisory Committee. Recently served on an Institute of Medicine of the National Academies Panel dealing with Provision of Mental Health Counseling Services under TRICARE and the future of Allied Health Practice.

His educational preparation includes a B.S. in Occupational Therapy from the University of Kansas, an M.S. Ed. from the University of Southern California, a Ph.D. in Continuing and Vocational Education with an emphasis in continuing competency in the professions from the University of Wisconsin-Madison and successfully completed the University of Chicago's three week Management Development course. He is a Fellow in the American Occupational Therapy Association.
