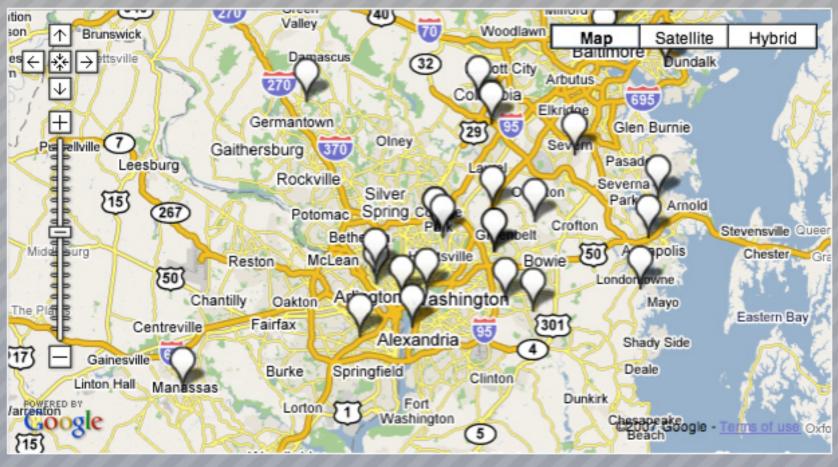

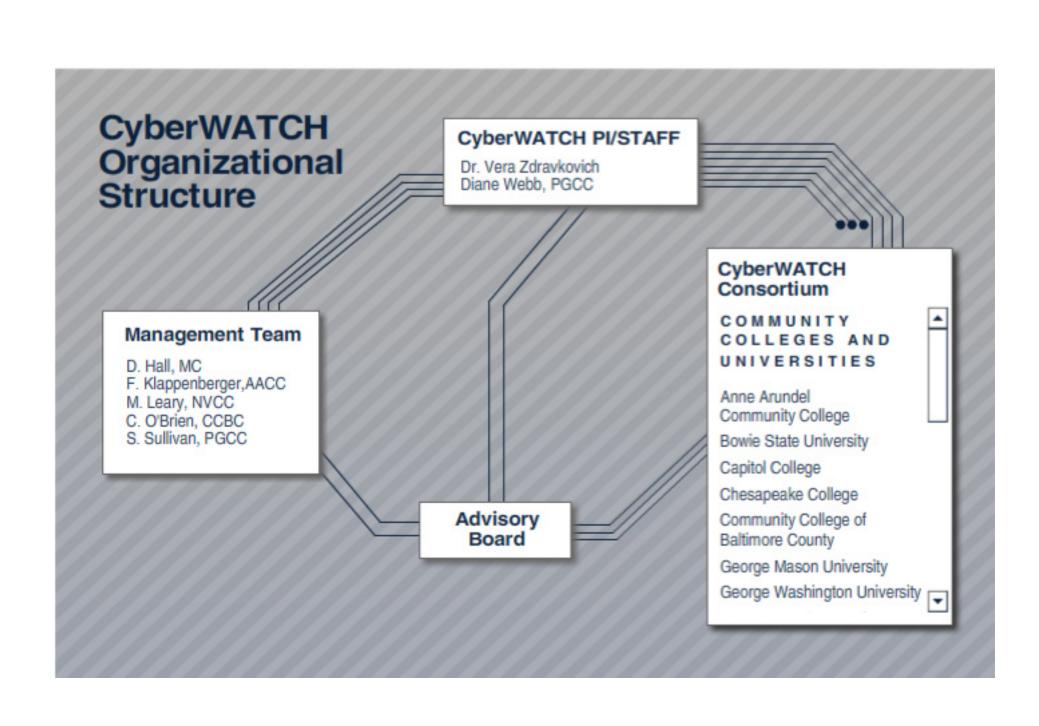

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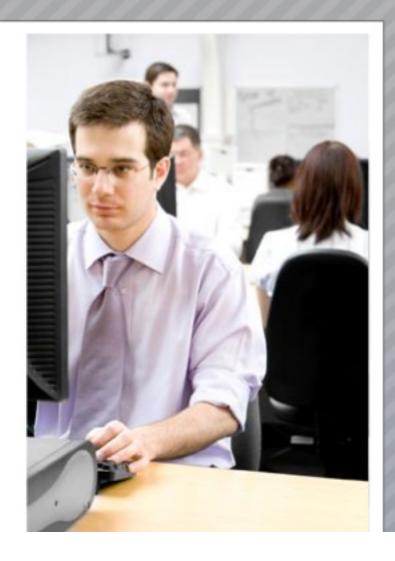
Centers of Academic Excellence

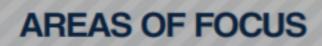
Description of CAE's

Six university partners are CAE's

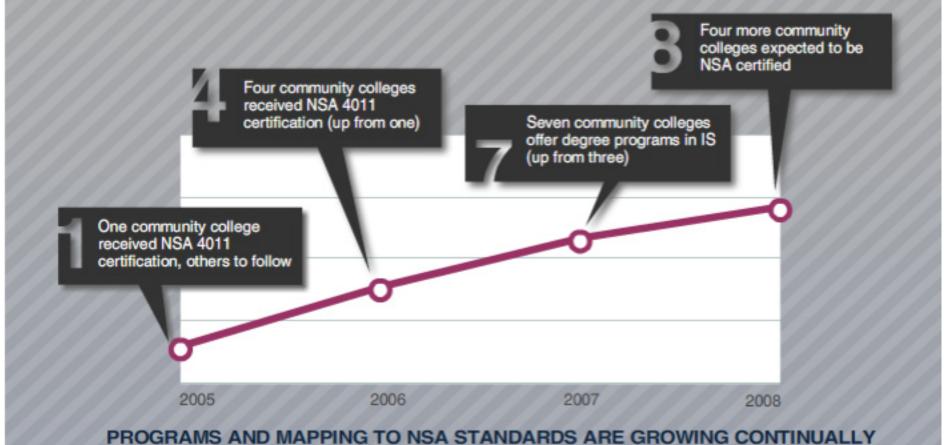

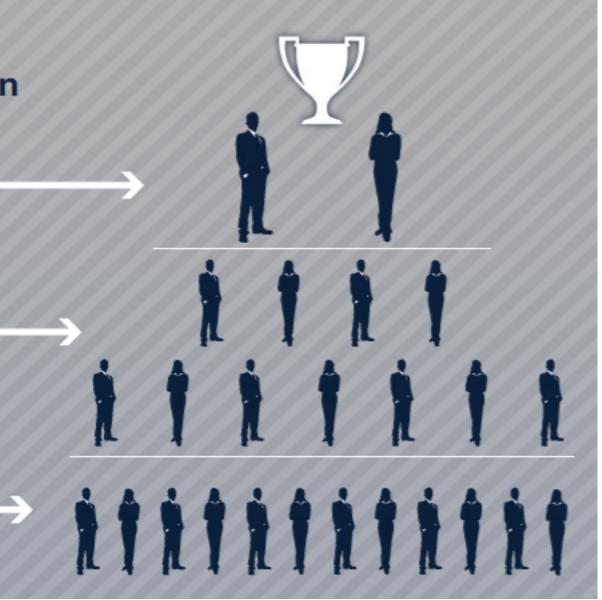
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Collegiate Cyber Defense Competition
