IT Information Protection Certification Program

- Today
 - The Department of Veterans Affairs has a contract in place to train CISSP candidates through 2010
 - Currently, there are 88 students preparing for their CISSP certification. As a supplement to their CISSP studies, students attend Network+ and Security+ training
- The number of certified staff is increasing
 - CISSP training program produced 182 certified VA staff
 - CSP training program produced 1,249 certified VA staff
 - Network + program produced 50 certified VA staff
 - Security+ program produced 25 certified VA staff
- Program details are on the VA's Information Protection Portal

- Contract awarded for MCSE, Security, Security+, and CCNA/CCNP
- Pilot program for Microsoft and Cisco Systems certification training. Students are assessed, study before the course, and attend an all inclusive certification boot camp
