**Overview:** ISS-LOB Tier I Awareness, Shared Service Centers, and Distance Learning all seem to be the hot topics for Cyber Security Awareness in 2007. Although the April 30<sup>th</sup> deadline for agencies to report to OMB who they will select as a shared service center has passed, many agencies requested waivers or requested more time to decide. Since this is an important and timely issue for the federal information system security awareness and training community, FISSEA wanted to focus the May 23<sup>rd</sup> workshop on Awareness and Distance Learning. Thus, for our May 23<sup>rd</sup> workshop, we invited representatives from each of the Shared Service Centers to discuss their approach to providing distance learning cyber security awareness products. Following the panel discussion, we will have an interactive discussion and sharing of ideas, thoughts, and experiences about how we can work together as a federal community to meet the goals of the ISS LOB Tier I Awareness Shared Service Centers: (1) to reduce duplication; (2) to provide economies of scale; and (3) to improve security.
